

A 2004 Trinity Lutheran Seminary graduate, Pastor Karl Biermann served as a parish pastor for 10 years in his native Texas before answering the call in 2014 to serve as assistant to the bishop in the Northeastern Ohio Synod (Cleveland/Akron/Youngstown).

Pr. Biermann and his wife of 26 years, Lana, enjoyed living in Ohio during his seminary studies in Columbus, pastoral internship at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Upper Arlington (Columbus), and campus ministry experience at Capital University.

Pr. Biermann and Lana have a 20-year-old college student daughter and 18year-old high school senior son. Beloved home base is Centerville, Ohio near Dayton, so that Pastor Biermann might be more centrally located for his ministry as the ELCA Foundation's Regional Gift Planner for Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, and Lower Michigan.

Our **Annual Meeting** will be on May 4th at 9:00 am in the Fellowship Hall. We will be electing a new council member, synod representatives, and next year's nominating committee as well as voting on a new budget. Please plan on attending as we need 50 voting members to constitute a quorum.

From Bethlehem's Constitution and Bylaws: C8.02.c. "Voting members are confirmed members. Such confirmed members, during the current or preceding calendar year, shall have communed in this congregation and shall have made a contribution of record to this congregation. Members of this congregation who have satisfied these basic standards shall have the privilege of voice and vote at every regular and special meeting of this congregation as well as the other rights and privileges ascribed to voting members by the provisions of this constitution and its bylaws. They shall not have voted as a seasonal member of another congregation of this church in the previous two calendar months."





Our **next Service Sunday** will be May 4 which is also the date of the Annual Meeting. So in place of a work project day, during the month of May 2025, Bethlehem has chosen to support **Exodus Refugee**. Exodus has a long history of welcoming refugees and asylees from many countries, cultures, languages, faiths, and political opinions. They began in 1981 with the mission to serve the legal needs of immigrants and Cuban refugees, who had arrived as part of the Mariel boatlift in 1980. Since that time, Exodus has helped thousands of refugees establish their lives in Indiana. Recent changes in government support make our support more important than ever. 25 April 2025: Mark, Evangelist — "St. Mark the Evanglist", red St. Mark the Evangelist's symbol is a winged lion, which also represents John the Baptist's preaching in the wilderness which mark likened to a lion's roar. (This shield is on the south ceiling.)

27 April 2025: Second Sunday of Easter — "The Resurrection", white The legend of the phoenix, burning to death and rising young and rejuvenated from the ashes, is the basis for this Easter symbol.
