General Operating Net Income Update and Appeal

As of November 30, 2024, net income for Bethlehem's general operating fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 was (\$35,742), which is a negative figure. Actual receipts for the period were \$127,844 as compared to budgeted receipts of \$169,278. Actual expenses for the fiscal year were \$163,586 as compared to budgeted expenses of \$169,278. The main driver of the negative net income figure was smaller giving totals of \$17,270 in October and \$12,013 in November. We need pledges and offerings of \$33,206 per month to be on budget. This amounts to \$7,663 per week.

Please check your funds available and consider additional giving. Regular giving is most helpful for meeting monthly expenses, and this can be automated via VANCO or your bank's bill paying service.

How to Give Gifts of Securities to Bethlehem

Bethlehem uses LPL Financial as the broker for managing security donations. Below is the information you need to donate shares to Bethlehem.

For calendar year-end gifts, please initiate your donation well in advance of December 31st to allow time for processing and settlement. The securities must be received in Bethlehem's LPL account on or before December 31st for your tax purposes in 2024.



22 December 2024: Fourth Sunday of Advent — "The Passover", violet (blue)

The door lintel and jambs smeared with blood represent God's protection of the Hebrews from the angel of death.

25 December 2024: Nativity of Our Lord — "Christmas Manger", white

This symbolizes the Lord's nativity.

26 December 2024: Stephen, Deacon and Martyr — "St. Stephen", red

Falsely accused of blasphemy, St. Stephen was stoned to death in the first century CE (Acts 7). The symbol of this first Christian martyr is a coat and three stones.
