March Service Sunday is coming up! Join us on March 2nd at 9a to assist <u>Laundry & More</u>, a Lawrence-based organization that exists for families to wash their clothes and bedding for free. We'll make sandwiches for families served by Laundry & More and collect monetary

and supply donations for the organization - they spend about \$11 per family for coins in the laundry machines. Quarters, dollars, and checks can be made out to BLC (note Laundry & More in the memo line). In addition to financial donations, we are collecting laundry detergent pods, waterless detergent sheets, dryer sheets, and 30 gallon heavy-duty garbage bags. They are not collecting liquid detergent at this time.

Laundry & More also provides sandwiches to the 40-50 families they serve at each washing and we are looking for volunteers interested in assembling sandwiches in the kitchen. Donations of individual/snack size packages of goldfish-type or snack crackers are also welcome for kids that accompany their caregivers to the laundromat.
