General Operating Net Income Update and Appeal

As of December 31, 2024, net income for Bethlehem's general operating fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 was (954), which is a negative figure. Actual receipts for the period were \$187,067 as compared to budgeted receipts of \$203,134. Actual expenses for the fiscal year were \$188,021 as compared to budgeted expenses of \$203,134.

December was a big comeback month for us on the fiscal front. The net income figure at the end of November was (\$35,742), which is a much bigger negative figure. But in December, pledges and offerings totaled \$58,506 which well exceeded the \$33,206 per month that we need to be on budget. There were also some savings on the expense side in several categories that helped to provide this result. So hearty thanks go out to all who contributed!
