Join us for Service Sunday on February 2nd at 9:00 for a service project helping Indy Urban Acres (IUA), a local non-profit urban farm started in 2011 that harvests 60,000 pounds of produce annually at four sites and distributes all of its produce to local community partners that serve individuals experiencing food insecurity. IUA serves 250 families in need through its farm share veggie box program and also distributes food through 20 distribution partners including Gleaners Food Bank and New Bethel Food Pantry. In addition to growing food for those in need, IUA also grows over 30,000 native plants throughout winter and hosts an annual native plant sale every Spring to help fund this incredible operation. Our Service Sunday project will help create species tags for the native plants currently being grown in their eastside greenhouse!
