From Bethlehem's Constitution and Bylaws: C8.02.c. "Voting members are confirmed members. Such confirmed members, during the current or preceding calendar year, shall have communed in this congregation and shall have made

a contribution of record to this congregation. Members of this congregation who have satisfied these basic standards shall have the privilege of voice and vote at every regular and special meeting of this congregation as well as the other rights and privileges ascribed to voting members by the provisions of this constitution and its bylaws. They shall not have voted as a seasonal member of another congregation of this church in the previous two calendar months."

Since this Sunday would also be our **Service Sunday**, we will be kicking off our month long service project, **Exodus Refugee**. Exodus has a long history of welcoming refugees and asylees from many countries, cultures, languages, faiths, and political opinions. They began in 1981 with the mission to serve the legal needs of immigrants and Cuban refugees, who had arrived as part of the

Mariel boatlift in 1980. Since that time, Exodus has helped thousands of refugees establish their lives in Indiana. Recent changes in government support make our support more important than ever. You can find out about this wonderful organization on the web at https://www.exodusrefugee.org.

Can you find this week's shields?

1 May 2025: Philip and James, Apostles — "St. Philip / St. James the Less", red (scarlet)

The tau cross and bread basket are symbols of the apostle Philip referring to his participation in the feeding of the multitude and for his work in spreading the word of Christ.

James is represented by a hand saw, a symbol of his martyred remains being sawn asunder. (These shields are on the south ceiling.)

4 May 2025: Third Sunday of Easter — "Eternal Life", white The three stages of a butterfly are likened to humanity: larva--lowly, sinful; chrysalis--the body in the grave; and the brightly colored butterfly emerges as Christ rose and ascended into heaven and as believers in Christ will.
