

This Sunday: LCFS Christmas Store collection & Crismons

The Lutheran Child & Family Services Christmas Store will take place December 2-December 6 at Cornerstone Lutheran Church, 2837 E. New York Street. Starting now through **December 1**, we are collecting items from the <u>donation wish list</u>. Donations will be collected in baskets placed in the hallway by the church office.

During Service Sunday on December 1 from 9a-10a, we will load donations into one or two vehicles and transport donations to Cornerstone Lutheran Church. There are also opportunities to help set up the store at Cornerstone Lutheran Church for the afternoon of December 1 from 1p-5p. Sign up for volunteer shifts <u>here</u>.

Also during Service Sunday, we will be making Chrismon ornaments to deliver to those we go a'caroling to on December 14.

Advent by Candlelight - Thursday, December 5, 7pm Our annual women's event is next week. All women (members, former member, friends, daughters and their friends) are invited to an evening of fellowship over desserts, followed by a 30 minute seasonal devotional service. Our only request is an <u>RSVP</u> so we can ensure dessert for all.

Table hostesses are needed, if you are willing to provide dessert for 8 people and a centerpiece - please consider hostessing a table. Better yet hostess with a friend. The church has table service (or you may bring your own), napkins, flatware, coffees, and teas.

Lastly, we really want to see all of you. If you need a ride or child service please let us know as soon as possible so we can make arrangements. And, yes - the devotional portion will be streamed.

Christmas Caroling In just a few weeks we'll be sending out Christmas Carolers from Bethlehem to visit members and friends of our community. When the lists have been gathered, an itinerary will be planned and posted, so you have the option of meeting up with the carolers at only one or two chosen locations if that's all you can do. St. Lucia Celebration: Please join in the St. Lucia festivities on Sunday, December 15, in Fellowship Hall at 9:00 am. This festival is traditionally re-enacted in Scandinavian homes on the morning of Dec.13 to celebrate the beginning of the Christmas season, and add a touch of brightness to a long winter. A child of the household, wearing a white gown with a red sash and a wreath of lighted candles on her/his head, leads the other children on a breakfast procession through the home, with a tray of pastries. At Bethlehem, we include traditional Scandinavian foods, but also welcome finger foods from the many cultures and traditions of our members. We invite you to share a food from your own ethnic background, or try one of the Scandinavian recipes posted on the bulletin board in the hallway. Hope to see you there.

Can you find this week's shields?

30 November 2024: Andrew, Apostle — "St. Andrew", red The cross saltire, with arms of equal length extending to the edges of the shield is a common symbol of St. Andrew. Legend says he died on a cross of that configuration. The boat hook is a reference to his travels in spreading the gospel.

1 December 2024: First Sunday of Advent — "Encircled Globe", violet (blue) A serpent coiled around the earth symbolizes the fall of humanity. This symbol is associated with the Virgin Mary and the fulfillment of the prophecy, "the seed of the woman shall bruise the head of the serpent".
