Become a Stephen Minister and You Will Change Lives <u>Especially your</u> <u>own</u>

My neighborhood learned something strange when Covid struck in 2020.

Sure, we always waved, we knew names, and we thought we knew each other – but we honestly didn't. I doubt that we would have called each other "Friend". I thought back on that when I recently went to a very nice Eclipse Party, with a wonderful group down the street. I suddenly realized things certainly have changed for the better!

Research tells us that having different "groups" of friends is healthy. It makes you more interesting. It also increases the satisfaction and comfort you feel with your life, since different groups of friends can (and do) offer you different types of support.

You may already have your "work friends", your family friends, your "church" friends, and maybe some of your neighbors. But are you willing to expand your circle? Science says that adding more personal "connections" makes a happier you!

This is your invitation to add a new group, pick up some remarkable skills, and change your own life. The Stephen Ministry Program is starting a new class this fall. This training is offered as a weekly class over about 16 weeks, and your classmates will be from Cross & Crown Lutheran Church and Bethlehem Lutheran Church. You'll learn about the importance of confidentiality, how much empathy changes people, and most importantly, the healing and sustaining power of truly connecting with someone.

Liturgical Shields

In 1945, Pastor Don Elder created two shields decorated with liturgical symbols--one for the Epiphany of Our Lord, and one for Reformation Sunday. He organized an Ecclesiastical Arts Group in 1949 and proposed decorating the entire ceiling of the sanctuary with similar shields to represent every Sunday, Principal Festival, and Lesser Festival celebrated in the church year at that time. Pastor Elder designed two series of shields (essentially the church year twice), 130 shields in total, and the EAG painted them, completing the project in 1952.

The shields don't always correspond to particular lectionary readings of the day, but they do draw on the themes for the seasons and incorporate symbols related to them. Each series runs from the top row to the bottom, from the front of the nave to the back.

These shields correspond to the Sundays and festival days of April this year in the South series:

21 April 2024: Fourth Sunday of Easter—"Fountain of Salvation", white This heraldic symbol of a fountain refers to Zechariah 13:1, "In that day there shall be a fountain open to the House of David... for sin and uncleanness."

25 April 2024: Mark, Evangelist—"St. Mark the Evangelist", red Saint Mark the Evangelist's symbol is a winged lion, which also represents John the Baptist's preaching in the wilderness, which Mark likened to a lion's roar.

28 April 2024: Fifth Sunday of Easter—"Good Shepherd", white The Lord as the good shepherd is based on John 10:11, "I am the Good Shepherd." He is usually shown as a young, beardless man with a lamb over his shoulders.
