- -Hunger Relief Kitchen. Daily, using the donated food, Second Helpings prepares approximately 5,000 meals that are delivered to more than 100 agencies in the Indianapolis area.
- -Culinary Training. Second Helpings continually offers culinary training classes for unemployed and underemployed persons seeking a career in the food service industry. Since it's inception, more than 1,000 persons have been trained.

Liturgical Shields

In 1945, Pastor Don Elder created two shields decorated with liturgical symbols--one for the Epiphany of Our Lord, and one for Reformation Sunday. He organized an Ecclesiastical Arts Group in 1949 and proposed

decorating the entire ceiling of the sanctuary with similar shields to represent every Sunday, Principal Festival, and Lesser Festival celebrated in the church year at that time. Pastor Elder designed two series of shields (essentially the church year twice), 130 shields in total, and the EAG painted them, completing the project in 1952.

The shields don't always correspond to particular lectionary readings of the day, but they do draw on the themes for the seasons and incorporate symbols related to them. Each series runs from the top row to the bottom, from the front of the nave to the back.

These shields correspond to the Sundays and festival days of July this year in the South series:

21 July 2024: Time after Pentecost (Lectionary 16) — "St. Jude the Apostle", red (green)

A carpenter by trade, Jude's missionary vision took him on extensive travels with Simon. Thus, Jude's shield is a boat hook and a carpenter's square.

25 July 2024: James, Apostle; and 28 July 2024: Time after Pentecost (Lectionary 17) — St. James the Greater", red (green)

The scallop shell does not refer to St. James or any event in his life, but symbolizes him because the scallop shell was the badge of pilgrims to his shrine at Compostella, Spain. The scallop shell eventually became the badge of any Christian pilgrim.

Liturgical festivals for which there are no shields:

31 May 2024: Visit of Mary to Elizabeth 22 July 2024: Mary Magdalene, Apostle
